
TOOLS TO HELP OTHERS

There are many hurting people in the world today who want help. Often it is either their own hurt or someone else's:

- troubling behaviors
- paralyzing fear
- crippling anxiety.

Whatever the need, more often than not, they want RELIEF from their burden, shame, or guilt. Desiring to primarily provide relief is where we often go wrong.

There is a greater need!

Our most important role in the lives of those we serve lies herein:

- Do we have an understanding of what they know about God?
- Do we see their misbeliefs, their misinterpretations of Him?
- Do they think Him exacting, harsh, lenient, detached, or mean?
- Do they know that the steadfast love of the Lord never ceases?
- Do they know the wonder of who God is, what He's done, and what He's promised? *

IT ALL BEGINS with what we BELIEVE.

WHAT ONE BELIEVES ABOUT GOD IS THE MOST IMPORTANT THING TO TRULY HELP HURTING PEOPLE

We provide:

Classes, interactive groups, etc. all geared to encourage and strengthen the beliefs of hurting people – helping those who want to encourage others or those who need to be encouraged to interpret their difficulties through a biblical framework.

Self-Confrontation begins the process in both discipling and counseling.

We learn to realistically evaluate our personal agendas and compare them to God's goal for our lives, which is to be conformed to the image of His Son Jesus Christ. (Romans 8:29)

Do we really BELIEVE God works all things together for good to those who love Him. (Romans 8:28)

When we confront our belief system, we begin to see our biggest problem is not people and circumstances, but our own heart's focus: self focus (our agenda) or God focus (His agenda)? What transforms our heart?

"As we BEHOLD the glory of God we are transformed." Changing our focus from our goal to God's. (2 Corinthians 3:18)

"It's not the experiences of our lives that change us. It is our response to those experiences." E. Elliott

WHAT WE BELIEVE AND WHAT WE BEHOLD BRINGS ABOUT CHANGE

If CHANGE does not grow out of what we believe and behold, it will result in behavior modification and self-righteous independence rather than the glory of God and true heart change.

CHANGE is the natural outcome as we turn our face toward God and BEHOLD HIM. It is the natural by-product of our growing intimacy with God.

As we realize the sin or suffering was useful medicine designed by God for His glory and our good, we want to STUDY to show ourselves approved, not ashamed, as we accurately handle the word of truth. (2 Timothy 2:15).

- proclaim liberty to the captives
 bring sight to the blind,
- free the oppressed.
